Over Half a Million Home Care Visits



The sheer volume of care provided by our amazing PSWs and nurses is astounding. Our PSWs made 384,273 home visits last year, up 11% from the previous year. Our incredible nurses provided 138,776 patient visits, up 2.5% from the previous year – that's over half a million care visits in total last year. Home care is the key to helping people live at home for as long as possible!

Caregivers Need More Help

Once again, there was a huge leap in demand for dementia related caregiver support. We helped 740 people this year - up 23% over last year - through 3,215 family consultations, support group sessions, workshops and events. More Because You Care funding will be invested in this area this coming year to better meet demand.

This Is Caregiving

I'm caring for my wife of 53 years – a second marriage for both of us. My wife's first marriage was to an abusive person, which severely traumatized her. Now, with the progression of her dementia, she sometimes confuses me with her abusive husband from the past. She doesn't recognize me at times, waking up in the middle of the night attacking me to protect herself, running towards strangers in the parking lot or apartment building to ask for help. I didn't know how to handle these situations so I reached out to Acclaim Health for help. It was a relief to learn about therapeutic fibs and how to handle these situations when she didn't know who I was. I developed coping strategies for when she was feeling unsafe, like walking away to give her physical space, using Acclaim Health's caregiver cards that I can discreetly hand to strangers to let them know what's going on. I've also used JIM's Suites because she feels very safe there and it gives me a break. I was getting so burnt out, but joining the support groups, getting help, attending the education sessions has kept me going.

The Music Mind Connection



Our music therapy capacity has doubled in the last year thanks to the support of our incredible donors and funders - but we're not stopping there! Acclaim Health is working towards becoming Music Care Certified™ (a two-year process), so that we're able to infuse music into much of the care we provide. The benefits are enormous for our clients, patients and club members − including reduced stress, anxiety and frustration, and an increased sense of connection − AND JOY!

Private Care That Provides... More Community Care!

Private care saw a 14% increase in volumes year over year, partly due to our popular foot care service. This increase in volume has an extra wonderful side effect – it generates more care for the community. All of the surplus from our private care social enterprise is reinvested in our other community programs. Private care clients get the care they need, while helping others in their community. It's a beautiful thing!

Reducing Social Isolation One iPad At a Time




Older adults who can't use technology are getting left behind and are often lonelier than their peers. Our Technology Accessibility pilot ran this year to address the issue, and had such strong results that it will now become a full-fledged program thanks to an Ontario Trillium Foundation grant. Older adults will learn how to access the internet, send emails, join video calls, play games, send text messages and more alongside their very own volunteer.

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

A Battle Won, The War Wages (ha!) On

Finally, after years of advocacy at the provincial level, Acclaim Health employees received permanent raises this year unhampered by Bill 124. The raises fell short of addressing the pay gap between home care and other healthcare settings, and did not mitigate the cost of living increases we have seen over the last few years – but it was a meaningful step in the right direction.

The Promise of Ontario Health Teams (OHTs)

Cool stuff is starting to happen! Community Wellness Hubs are spreading across our region, and deep collaboration across sector partners is developing best practices for wrap around care. Acclaim Health is a big part of this work to shape the future of healthcare through the Connected Care Halton OHT, the Burlington OHT and the Mississauga OHT.

Inclusive Care for Everyone



To do that, we need to do better. Acclaim Health is intentionally and tangibly working towards a more equitable and inclusive community – starting with ourselves. This year all Acclaim Health team members participated in learning opportunities, started to tackle painful issues like workplace harassment, and celebrated the unique lived experiences of our team. This is only the beginning! Addressing social justice issues – within our organization and in our community – is the only way to provide extraordinary care for EVERYONE.
